

# DOMAINE AUCHÈRE AOP SANCERRE ROUGE



## WINEMAKER

Jean-Jacques and Baptiste Auchère

## WINE REGION

Loire Valley

## STORY

The Auchère family's winemaking tradition has been passed from grandfather to father to son for generations. At the head of the family estate, Jean-Jacques Auchère personally approves each wine to assure quality and consistency.

## VINEYARD

The Auchère winery is located in the village of Bue, and their plots are sustainably farmed. The white vineyard is from those famous plots: Chêne Marchand, Les Monts Damnes, Chasseignes, Les Deserts. The white Cuvée is issued from a clay (Chavignol) and limestone soil (Bue and Sancerre).

## VINIFICATION

The vinification is performed by using traditional methods in stainless steel tanks, with a carbonic maceration to extract denser flavors. Light filtration before bottling.

## TASTING NOTES

The nose opens with pure minerality and hints of smoke and red fruit. The palate bursts in red currants and black cassis, balanced by sharp acidity and supple tannins. This wine is refreshing with a long finish.

## FOOD PAIRING

An excellent addition to grilled pork loin, lamb chops and hard cheeses.
